

How to create a custom affiliate link

You don't have to use your affiliate link just to send people to the Flywheel home page; in fact, you can create your own custom affiliate link that leads to any page on our site, from a blog post on the Layout to a help doc in our FAQ section.

Create a custom link like this:

[AFFILIATE LINK] + /?page=/ + the end of the getflywheel.com URL you're trying to share

To share our Creative Toolbox, you should have a link that ends up looking like this:

<http://share.getf.ly/1f2l3y/?page=/design-and-wordpress-resources/toolbox/>

To share a Layout blog post, you should have a link that ends up looking like this:

<http://share.getf.ly/1f2l3y/?page=/layout/20-badass-sites-built-on-wordpress/>

To share a URL on a Flywheel subdomain (which is where most of our ebooks live), you can create a custom link like this:

[AFFILIATE LINK] + /?custom_page=/ + the full highfive.getflywheel.com URL you'd like to share

For example, to share our high-converting ebook, “Recurring revenue: the secret to growing your agency,” you should have a link that ends up looking like this (with your own affiliate link, of course):

http://share.getflywheel.com/f12l3y/?custom_page=highfive.getflywheel.com/recurringrevenuesecret

Then you can stick that any of these links into a URL shortener (if you'd like) and you're good to go!
