SSL is incredibly important for eCommerce sites, as it's a protocol used to secure and encrypt communication between computers. Without it, your users' data could be compromised, which would result in a bad experience for them and decreased trust in your brand. Additionally, Google has started flagging sites without a certificate as insecure, which could seriously hurt both your traffic and conversions.

With an SSL certificate installed, however, your users will know that your site takes security seriously, which will immediately help build trust and encourage them to purchase from you. And thanks to Flywheel's partnership with Let's Encrypt, installing an SSL certificate on your site is easier than ever before (and free)!

Once your site is set up on Flywheel, you can add one of our free SSL certificates right from your site's dashboard. If you have a special certificate (such as wildcard or OV), there's also an option to bring your own for a small monthly fee.

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Optimize your site with custom caching settings

Oh caching...sometimes you can't live with it, other times you can't live without it. If it's a new concept for you, here's how it works.

When a user loads your site for the first time, the browser and server will store, or cache, the contents of your site locally. This includes HTML files, CSS stylesheets, images, and any other assets your site may contain. When your site's content is cached by a user's browser, that means the browser already has all of the assets it needs to load your site. This is beneficial because the next time that same user visits your site, the browser will be able to load the content without having to retrieve everything from the server again, meaning your site will load insanely fast!

Sounds great, right? It is! But here's the tricky part about eCommerce WordPress sites – the optimal caching set up is difficult to accomplish. You need your inventory pages to constantly update, but shopping carts to remember what's been added. You need new sales to launch without a hitch, but existing customer information to keep people logged in. And if you've ever tried to tackle these settings yourself, you've probably ran into this stressful back and forth of setting up caching rules.
